

unguis-cati, cat's claw creeper, *Nephrolepis cordifolia*, fishbone fern, or *Acmena smithii*, lilly pilly growing with the *Lagerstroemia indica*, crepe myrtle plants at the locations shown on Figure 16, other than at 593 Brookfield Road, Brookfield.

A table (Table 1 below) summarises the plant species I identified from Property Tag P1200139648 (Forensic Barcode No 383279538) (located in hair, on arms and around head of the deceased), the plant species I saw or did not see at Kholo Creek bridge (the area where the deceased was located) and the plants I saw at 593 Brookfield Road, Brookfield.

Thursday the 20th day of September 2012

A/Inspector Ewen Taylor came to the Queensland Herbarium on Thursday the 20th day of September 2012 at about 0830 hrs and we then attended at the Bunya Street Scout camp, Anstead. Upon arriving A/Inspector Taylor and I then met with Scenes of Crime officer Senior Constable Nicole Tadina. We then walked down to Kholo Creek and walked along it towards Kholo Creek bridge, along the western bank and then further along the eastern bank to the end of the track. I inspected the plants along this section of Kholo Creek and I did not see any plants of *Lagerstroemia indica*, crepe myrtle, *Dolichandra unguis-cati*, cat's claw creeper, *Nephrolepis cordifolia*, fishbone fern, or *Acmena smithii*, lilly pilly. The creek was lined with *Casuarina*
