TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

- a. Any offense reports of any law enforcement officer or officers or investigators involved in the investigation, arrest and/or detainment of the Defendant herein;
- b. Any documents, papers, written or recorded statements of the Defendant;
- c. Any documents, papers, written or recorded statements of any witness which the prosecuting attorney may call as a witness herein;
- d. Any photographs, audio or video recordings of the Defendant, witnesses, victims, or alleged crime scenes;

e. Any books, accounts, ledgers, letters, photographs, or other tangible objects involved in the investigation and/or prosecution of this offense;

f. Any tangible property of any type seized during any arrest, search, detainment of the Defendant herein;

g. Any evidence which is exculpatory, impeachment or mitigating document, item or information in the possession, custody or control of the State, and law enforcement agency, or any State agency that tends to negate the guilt of the Defendant or would tend to reduce the punishment for the offense charged;

h. The names, current addresses, current telephone numbers, of any witness which may be called by the prosecution in this cause pursuant to Rules 702, 703, and 705 of the Texas Rules of Evidence;

i. The criminal history of each and every witness the prosecution may call as a witness in this cause; but not including the work product of counsel for the State in the case and their investigators employed by the prosecuting attorney for the State, nor their notes, nor written communications between the State and an agent, representative, or employee of the State that constitute or contain evidence material to any matter involved in this cause. 
information to the Defendant, his attorney of record and the Court.

SCHEDULING ORDER

On this date, the Court has determined that the following scheduling order is appropriate for the disposition of this case.

PRE-TRIAL CONFERENCE AND HEARING

Pursuant to Article 28.01 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, a pre-trial conference and hearing is scheduled before the Court on September 28, 2022, at 1:30 p.m. and on November 9, 2022, at 2:00 p.m. A final plea hearing is scheduled for February 10, 2023, at 10:00 a.m.

The purpose of the pre-trial conference and hearing is to review any pending motions of the Defendant, hear all controverted or evidentiary matters, or other permissible matters pertinent to the case and issue such other orders as the Court deems necessary in this case.

JURY TRIAL

This case is scheduled for jury trial on April 11, 2023, at 9:00 a.m.

State's Duties

Prior to the November 9, 2022 pre-trial hearing, the State shall review the indictment. At the November 9, 2022 pre-trial hearing, the State shall be expected to announce whether the State is prepared to proceed to trial on the indictment. Further, the State shall be prepared to advance any pre-trial issues. If the State intends to make a plea offer, the State must make the plea offer to the Defendant's Attorney not later than seven (7) days prior to the February 10, 2023 final plea

hearing. If timely requested, the State must disclose to the Defendant's Attorney the information required by Tex. Code. Crim. Proc. Art. 39.14(b) not later than the 20th day before trial.

Defendant's Duties

The Defendant shall file all pre-trial motions at least seven (7) days before the November 9, 2022 pre-trial hearing, including but not limited to the following: (1) exceptions to the form or substance of the indictment; (2) motions to suppress evidence; (3) motions for change of venue; (4) motions for discovery; (5) special pleas; if any; (6) motions for appointment of interpreter; and (7) motions to set aside the indictment. If timely requested, the Defendant's Attorney must disclose to the State the information required by Tex. Code Crim Proc. Art. 39.14(b) not later than the 20th day before trial.

OTHER ORDERS

Motions *in limine*, may be filed at any time before trial begins. A written election for the jury to assess punishment may be filed at any time before the commencement of the *voir dire* examination of the jury panel. A written, sworn motion for jury-recommended community supervision under Tex. Code Crim. Proc. Art. 42A.055 may be filed at any time before trial begins.

The Attorney for the State, the Defendant's Counsel, and the Defendant SHALL be present at each pre-trial conference and hearing.

The Court will not consider motions that are not filed timely, except upon good cause supported by affidavit.

Each pre-trial conference and hearing, final plea hearing, and jury trial will all take place in the courtroom for the 32nd Judicial District Court, at the Nolan County Courthouse.

**PRETRIAL MOTION
MOTION FOR DISCOVERY OF
EVIDENCE OF EXTRANEIOUS OFFENSES (37.07)**

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

COMES NOW, SHAWN ADKINS, Accused, by and through Counsel and pursuant to the Texas Rules of Evidence and the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure moves the Court to order the District Attorney to give, in proper form, to counsel for the Accused timely notice of the proposed use of evidence, specifically:

1. The Defendant was indicted by the grand jury for the offense of Murder and Tampering with Evidence.

2. The Accused has filed a REQUEST FOR TIMELY NOTICE OF THE STATE'S INTENTION TO USE EVIDENCE OF EXTRANEIOUS MISCONDUCT AT TRIAL, of which the Court is requested to take judicial notice.

4. The accused has filed a request for notice, in addition to this discovery motion, because a motion for discovery and inspection does not constitute a request for notice regarding extraneous evidence testimony. *President v. State*, 926 S.W.2d 805, 808 (Tex. App.—Austin 1996). The Accused has therefore filed both in an abundance of caution.

5. Section 3(g) of Article 37.07, like Rule 404(b), addresses the admissibility of extraneous offense evidence. Unlike Rule 404(b), Section 3 of Article 37.07 deals exclusively with the admissibility of extraneous offense evidence at the punishment phase of trial. *Mitchell v. State*, 982 S.W.2d 425, 427 (Tex. Crim. App. 1998)

6. On timely request of the Accused, notice of intent to introduce evidence under this TEX. CODE CRIM. PROC. ANN. art 37.07 Section 3(g) shall be given in the same manner required by Rule 404(b), Texas Rules of Criminal Evidence. *Mitchell v. State*, 982 S.W.2d 425, 427 (Tex. Crim. App. 1998).

7. Neither does Section 3(g) of Article 37.07 define or otherwise specify what constitutes “reasonable” notice.

8. This motion, therefore, tracks a similar motion for notice of extraneous offense evidence under TEX. R. EVID. 404(b).

9. The accused moves the Court to order the prosecuting authority, pursuant to Section 3(g) of Article 37.07, to provide notice, at least 180 days prior to the commencement of trial, of his intent to introduce evidence in his case in chief of any other crimes, wrongs, or acts allegedly committed by Accused, other than those alleged in the Indictment or Information in this cause.

10. The Eighth Amendment requires a greater degree of accuracy and fact finding than would be true in a noncapital case. See *Gilmore v. Taylor*, 508 U.S. 333, 342 (U.S. 1993) (citing *Herrera v. Collins*, 506 U.S. 390, 399, 122 L. Ed. 2d 203, 113 S. Ct. 853 (1993); *Beck v. Alabama*, 447 U.S. 625, 65 L. Ed. 2d 392, 100 S. Ct. 2382 (1980)).

11. If Mr. ADKINS or his counsel does not have sufficient time to investigate any and all extraneous and/or unadjudicated acts of misconduct that the State may present at trial in this cause, he will be denied his rights in violation of the Fifth, Sixth, Eighth and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution, as well as article I § 10, 13, 15 and 19 of the Texas Constitution.

12. The ABA Guidelines for the Appointment and Performance of Defense Counsel in Death Penalty Cases (2003) Guideline 10.7 A states that “Counsel at every stage have an obligation to conduct thorough and independent investigations relating to the issues of both guilt and penalty.” This is repeated in the Texas State Bar Guidelines and Standards for Texas Capital Counsel (2006) Guideline 11.1. In order for the Accused's counsel to effectively investigate and defend against any and all extraneous and/or unadjudicated acts of misconduct that the State may present, counsel is entitled to discovery of such acts with sufficient notice. Due process requires that any unfair surprise to the Accused be avoided by notice to the Accused of the extraneous offenses that the State intends to offer at trial. *Kinnamon v. State*, 791 S.W.2d 84, 92 (Tex. Crim. App. 1990); *Spence v. State*, 795 S.W.2d 743, 759 (Tex. Crim. App. 1990); and *Matchett v. State*, 941 S.W.2d 922, 931 (Tex. Crim. App. 1996).

13. In order to provide the Accused with the effective assistance of counsel to which he is entitled under the Sixth Amendment to the United States Constitution, counsel must

thoroughly and timely investigate each of the alleged offenses and gather any evidence to rebut the allegations and mount appropriate collateral challenges to purported convictions. *Ex parte Tovar*, 901 S.W. 2d 484 (Tex. Crim. App. 1995).

14. It is therefore critical that the Accused receive sufficient notice in advance of trial to allow him to completely investigate each item disclosed under any order responsive to this motion.

15. Granting the Accused's request will help to avoid any last minute continuances that may be required to allow the defense to investigate or rebut any offered hearsay. The denial of timely notice will also hinder the Accused's counsel from properly conducting *voir dire* and other responsibilities during trial.

16. Moreover, the Accused prays the Court to order that any notice ordered also include for each incident, all discovery required to be produced by the District Attorney in this Court's discovery orders entered in this cause.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Accused moves the Court to order that the District Attorney provide counsel for the Accused with notices of intent to introduce evidence as specified in this request.
