FELONY INFORMATION

I, Matthew Durrett, Prosecuting Attorney within and for the Fourth Judicial District of the State of Arkansas, of which Washington County is a part, in the name and by the authority of the State of Arkansas, on oath, accuse the Defendant, HANNAH GRACE MCHALE, aka Alphonse Gray Mchale, of the crimes of: **Count 1: Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, a class B Felony, Count 2: Possession of a Schedule II Controlled Substance with Purpose to Deliver, a class C Felony**, committed as follows: The said Defendant on or about October 11, 2024, in Washington County, Arkansas, unlawfully and feloniously:

Count 1: On or about October 11, 2024, in Washington County, Arkansas, the said defendant did unlawfully possess drug paraphernalia with the purpose to use the drug paraphernalia to plant, propagate, cultivate, grow, harvest, manufacture, compound, convert, produce, process, prepare, test, analyze, pack, or repack a controlled substance that is methamphetamine, heroin, fentanyl, or cocaine, in violation of ACA §5-64-443(b)(2), **to-wit:** Defendant possessed a digital scale used

to analyze and pack methamphetamine, against the peace and dignity of the State of Arkansas.

Count 2: On or about October 11, 2024, in Washington County, Arkansas, the said defendant did unlawfully possess a Schedule II controlled substance, namely methamphetamine, less than 2 grams but with the purpose to deliver same, in violation of ACA §5-64-420(b)(1),

to-wit: Defendant was in possession of a digital scale, and more than 2 grams of methamphetamine in multiple different bags and syringes with the purpose to deliver, against the peace and dignity of the State of Arkansas.
