OFFICER AT THIS TIME TURNED THE VICTIM OVER ON HIS BACK AND HOWERED HIM TO THE FLOOR, PROPPING HIS HEAD. OFFICER THEN OBSERVED WHAT APPEARED TO BE AN ENTRANCE WOUND IN THE AREA OF THE VICTIM'S ABDOMEN SURROUNDED BY WHAT APPEARED TO BE TATTOOING MARKS. THERE WAS A SMALL AMOUNT OF RED LIQUID SUBSTANCE APPEARING TO BE BLOOD IN THE AREA OF THE WOUND. OFFICER LOCATED NO OTHER OBVIOUS SIGNS OF INJURY. THE VICTIM WAS DRESSED IN A BLACK T-SHIRT AND BLUE JEAN PANTS. AT THIS TIME OFFICER PHONED JASO HEADQUARTERS AND REQUESTED AMBULANCE ON CODE 3 AND PLACEMENT OF ROADBLOCKS.
	OFFICER OBSERVED A .22 CAL REVOLVER ON THE DRESSER-DRAWER TOP IN THE VICTIM'S BEAROOM. OFFICER ALSO FOUND THE FRONT GLASS OF AN AQUARIUM LOCATED ATOP THE CEDAR CHEST IN THE BEDROOM WITH THE FRONT GLASS BROKEN OUT ALLOWING CONTENTS TO ESCAPE VIA OPENING.

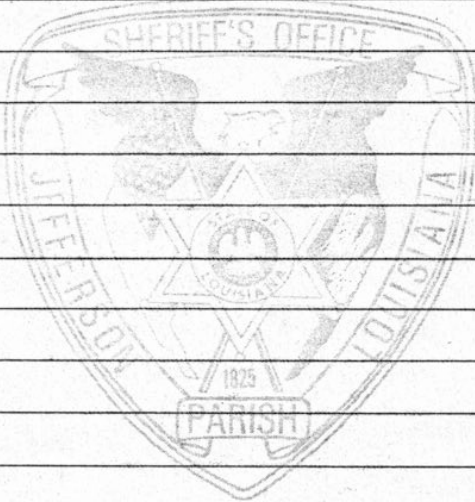
