On May 2, 1980, Dawn M. Ross, residing 1740 Hickory Street, Apartment B, Harahan, Louisiana voluntarily came to the Investigations Division, Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office, Gretna, Louisiana for the purpose of submitting to a polygraph examination.

The main issue under consideration was whether or not Miss Ross was telling the truth when she claimed she was not present in the room, did not struggle for the gun, and had not shot her boyfriend, Paul M. Montgomery, the victim of an apparent suicide on April 1, 1980, at 3401 Edenborn, Apartment 207, Metairie, Louisiana.

The facts concerning this case were provided Sergeant S. Chirchirillo by Sergeant V. Lamia, Offense Against Persons Division, Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office.

Before her pre-test interview, Miss Ross signed a copy of form stating
