### Dismemberment case

RACINE (AP) — A 1969 dismemberment case is being investigated again by Racine County Sheriff's Department deputies after a phone call from a Colorado woman. They said the woman claimed her brother may know something about the killing and dismemberment of Stephanie Marie Casberg, 17, of Milwaukee.

Racine County sheriff's detectives called the FBI in Hawaii in hopes of finding the woman's brother. Parts of Ms. Casberg's body were found July 9, 1969, by a boy fishing in the Root River. Her torso was found about two weeks later in a roadside ditch about five miles away. The Colorado woman told deputies her brother, who worked at a Milwaukee restaurant with the victim, left the state within days of Ms. Casberg's disappearance.
